Medical English I (ME I) is designed to help students become independent lifelong learners and healthcare professionals capable of using English to contribute to both local and global communities. The unit aims to develop students' intercultural awareness and communicative competence in general and medical contexts. Students will acquire English for Medical Purposes (EMP), which consists of Core English (general English) and Medical English Terminology.

Students will develop foundational English language skills necessary for academic success and professional communication. This includes:

- Strengthening general listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. (②④⑤)

Medical English

Students will acquire specialized language skills for medical and healthcare contexts. This includes:

- Developing an understanding of English as a tool for medical study and research. (②④⑤⑥)
- Learning medical terminology, affixes, and word structures used in professional settings. (②③④⑤)
- Practicing the use of general, health-related, and medical language in reading, speaking, and writing tasks. (②④⑤)

Global Awareness

Students will develop intercultural understanding and awareness to communicate effectively. (④⑤)

5.1 Unit Structure and Evaluation

Medical English I consists of two sessions (Sessions 1 and 2). In each session, students take three courses, each taught by a different instructor. Students are evaluated in each course by the respective instructor using assessment methods determined by the instructor (e.g., assignments, performance tasks, quizzes, final assessments, and unit examinations). A final score out of 100 is awarded for each course. Details of evaluation will be announced in each class and posted on the e-syllabus or Google Classroom by the respective instructor.

5.2 TOEFL

The TOEFL ITP® is administered to assess students' general English proficiency. It constitutes part of the summative assessment in the Reading/Grammar/TOEFL Preparation course.

5.3 Requirements for Unit Completion

Students must pass all courses in Sessions 1 and 2. The final evaluation for the unit is based on the combined results of all designated courses within the unit.

- Writing: Finish writing activities that were not completed in class. If necessary, revise previous work for resubmission.
